The School Values which we will be focussing on are: Independence, Enjoyment, Positive Attitudes

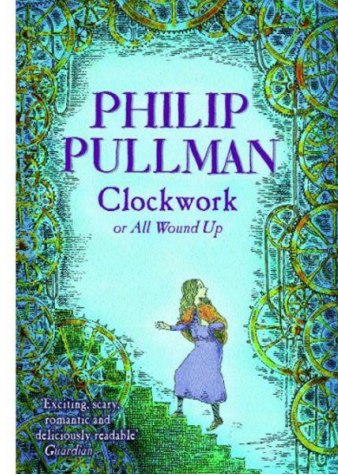
Stimulus/Starting Grid: A range of images and objects to stimulate conversation and imagination.

Geography

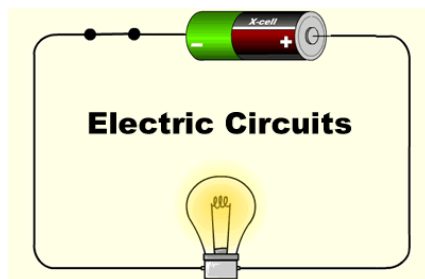
We will be learning about volcanoes and earthquakes.
