

Ruthless Romans

This term we will learn all about the 'Ruthless Romans' and how they were an important part of our history.

WOW task:

Meet a Roman Soldier and ask him about his life.

Science

As scientists we will continue to investigate changing states. Then, we will be learning about animals, including humans.

French

We will learn vocabulary linked to the theme 'Les animaux' (animals). Children will learn new vocabulary through playing games and speaking and listening activities.

Geography

We will learn about human Geography including settlements, land use, economic activity, trade links, natural resources and energy, food, minerals, water, etc...

Reading

This term we will continue to read from a variety of genres and develop our comprehension skills. We will also start a new class novel.

Music

As musicians, we will continue to learn how to play a musical instrument – the recorder.

ART/DT

We will design, create and evaluate a Roman shield. We will use clay to create a Roman sculpture.

Maths

As mathematicians we'll build on our multiplication and division skills and use this to solve complex mathematical problems. We will also be practising rapid recall of multiplication facts up to 12 x 12 in preparation for the multiplication test in spring. We will continue to send homework weekly.

Writing

We will read a range of texts linked to the Romans this term, including myths and legends.

We will be writing interesting and exciting myths using appropriate grammar, spelling and punctuation skills. We will also write non-fiction texts including reports and explanation texts.

Computing/Digital Literacy

In computing, we will collect, select, analyse and present data.

History

We will be learning about the impact that the Romans had on Britain.

PE

In PE, we will apply throwing and catching skills learnt last term in game situations. With Mrs Buxton, we will develop key skills in dance. PE kit is needed in school for Tuesday (indoor) and Friday (outdoor), please.

PSHCE

During lessons, we will learn how to keep ourselves safe.

RE

In RE, we will explore what can we learn from religions about deciding right and wrong?
