Pupils should be taught to:
-use their voices expressively &
creatively by singing songs, speaking
chants and rhymes
-play tuned & untuned instruments
-listen with concentration &
understanding to a range of highquality live & recorded music
-experiment with, create, select and
combine sounds using the inter-related
dimensions of music.

Pupils should be taught to:

- -play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression -improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music
- -listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory
- -use and understand staff and other musical notations
- -appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians
- -Develop an understanding of the history of music.
